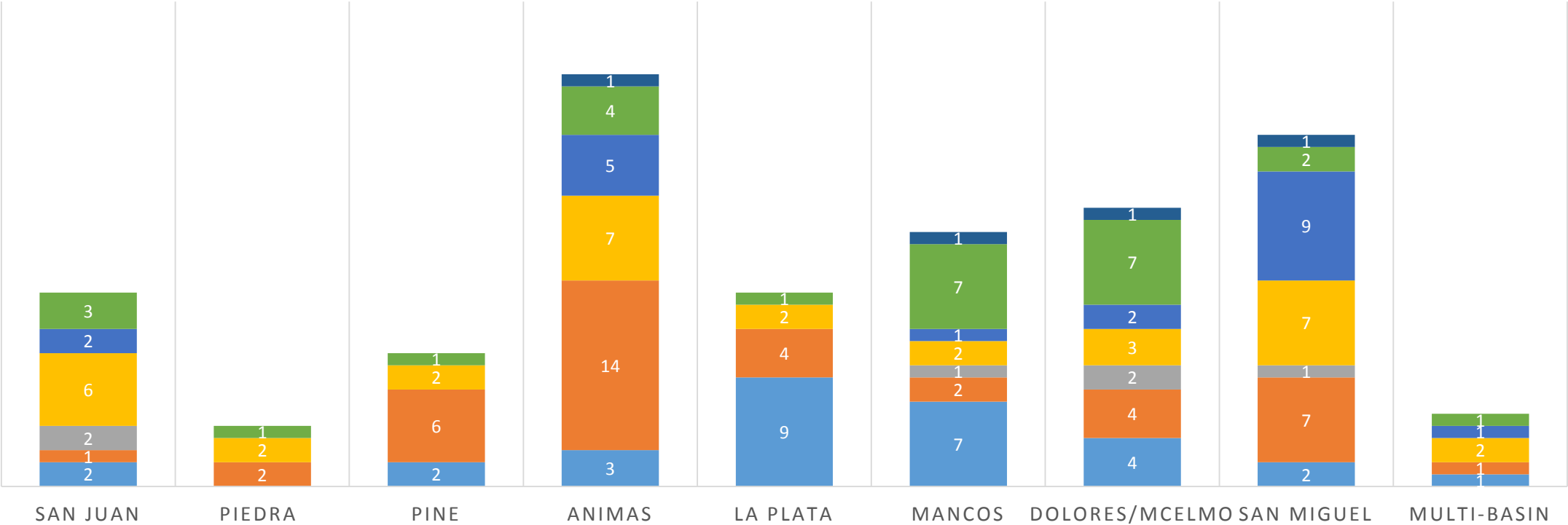

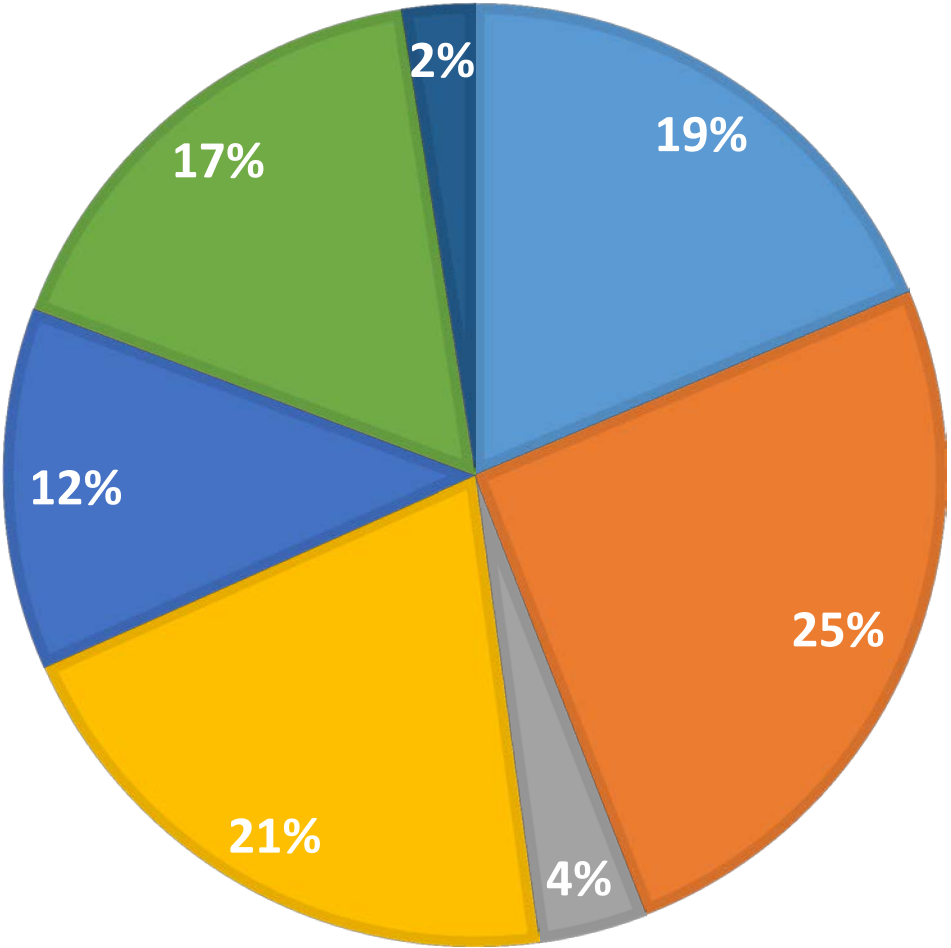
# IPPS SORTED BY SUB-BASINS

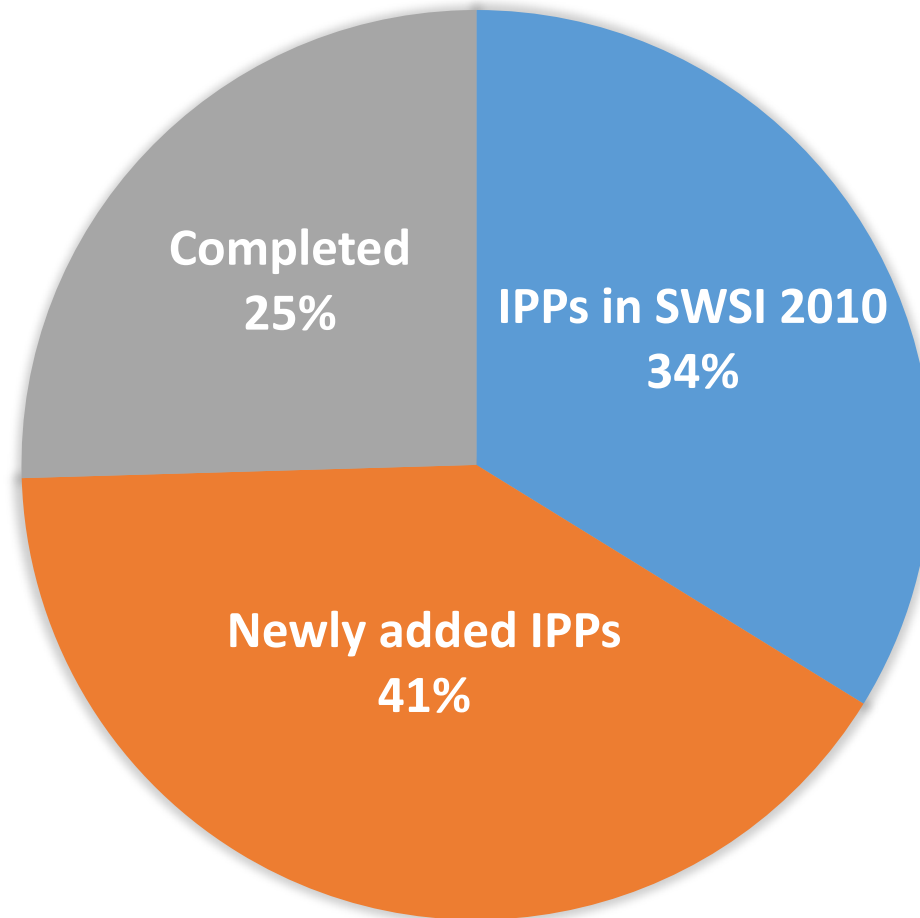
### IPPS SORTED BY NEEDS

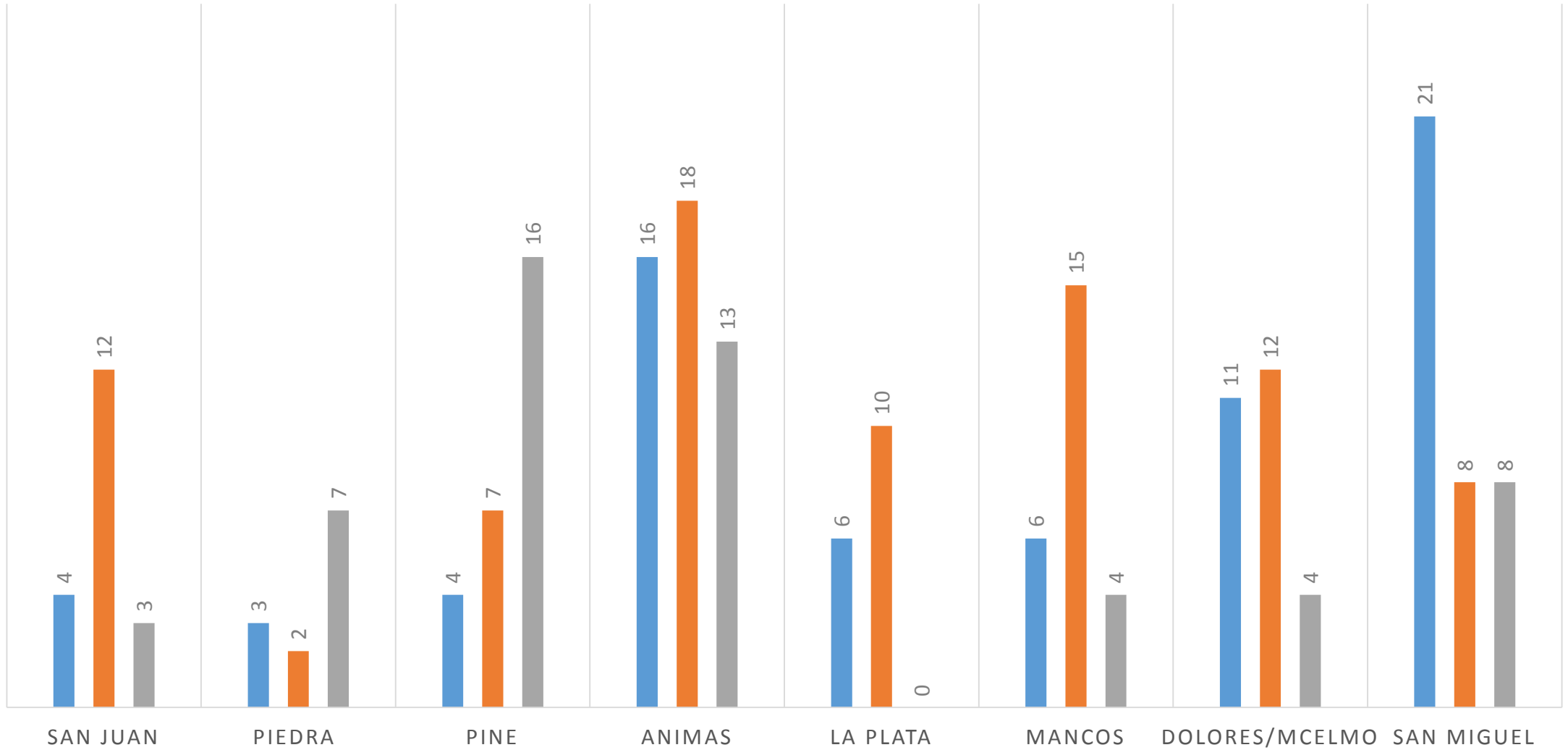
## TOTAL IPPS



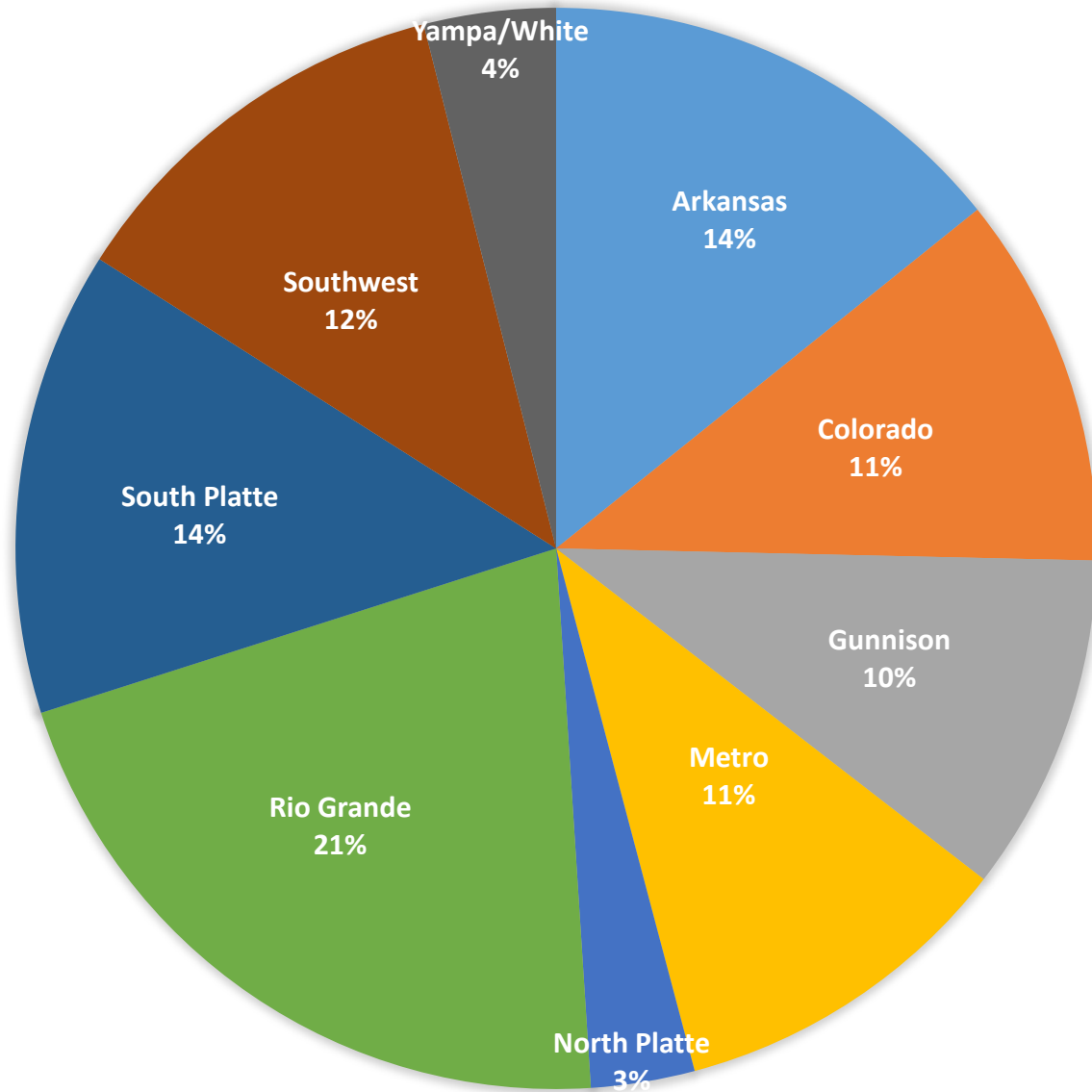


# IPPS UPDATE SINCE 2010

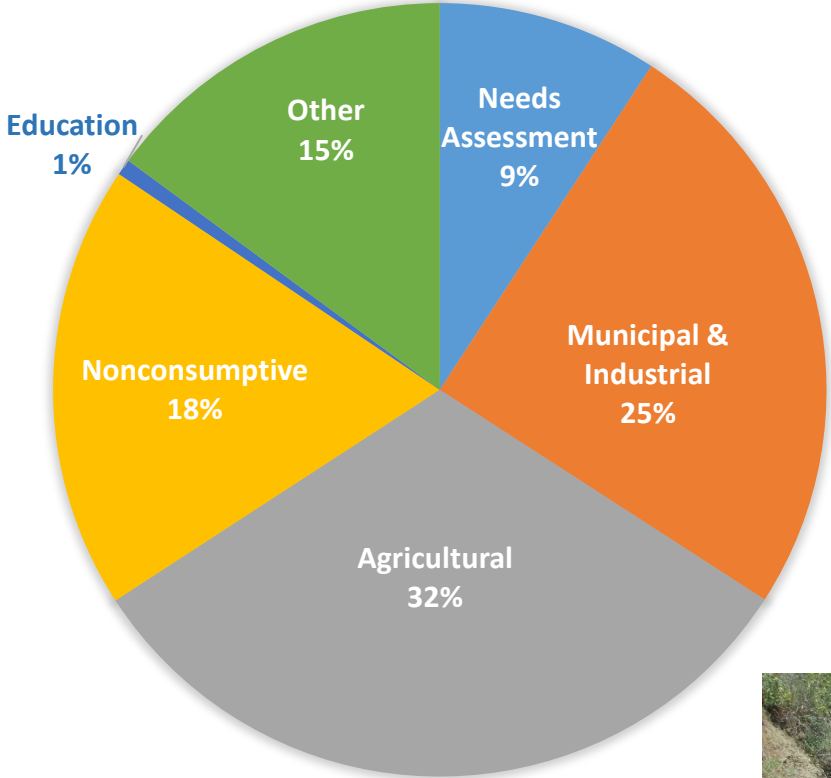

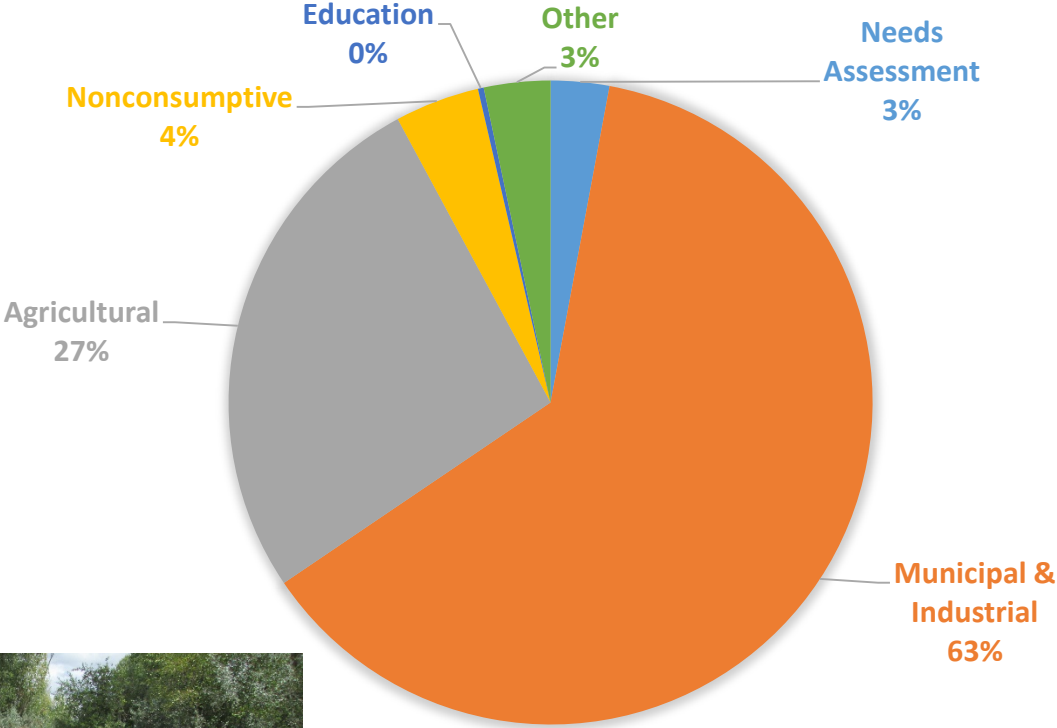
## BASIN & STATEWIDE FUND DISTRIBUTION
