RESOLUTION 2018-04 TO SET MILL LEVIES

A RESOLUTION LEVYING PROPERTY TAXES FOR THE YEAR 2018 TO HELP DEFRAY THE COSTS OF GOVERNMENT FOR THE SOUTHWESTERN WATER CONSERVATION DISTRICT, COLORADO, FOR THE 2019 BUDGET YEAR.

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of Southwestern Water Conservation District, has adopted the annual budget in accordance with the Local Government Budget Law, on December 4, 2018; and

WHEREAS, the amount of money necessary to balance the budget for general operating purposes from property tax revenue is \$1,555,900 for the general fund; and


WHEREAS, the 2018 valuation for assessment for the Southwestern Water Conservation District as certified by the County Assessors is \$3,822,849,358.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF SOUTHWESTERN WATER CONSERVATION DISTRICT, COLORADO.


That for the purpose of meeting all general operating expenses of the Southwestern Water Conservation District during the 2019 budget year, there is hereby levied a tax of .407 mills for the general operating fund upon each dollar of the total valuation for assessment of all taxable property within the County for the year 2018.

That Laura Spann, District Programs Coordinator, is hereby authorized and directed to certify to the County Commissioners of La Plata, Archuleta, Dolores, Hinsdale, Mineral, Montezuma, Montrose, San Juan and San Miguel Counties, Colorado, the mill levy for the Southwestern Water Conservation District as hereinabove determined and set based upon the final (December) certification of valuation from the county assessors.
